



GRADE SCALE AND PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS

Each teacher will distribute his/her grading policy on the first day of class.

A+	...	100 or greater (offered at the teacher's discretion)
A	...	94-100
A-	...	90-93
B+	...	87-89
B	...	83-86
B-	...	80-82
C+	...	77-79
C	...	73-76
C-	...	70-72
F	...	69 or below

Pass/Fail grades (P/F) will be issued for elective courses and for physical education credit. An elective's passing grade represents an average of 73 or above. An average below 73 (72.9) will be considered failing and no credit will be issued for that elective. A Pass grade will calculate as the equivalent of C when applied to an overall G.P.A.

Any student completing the school year with a G. P. A. below 1.67 for that particular year will not be allowed to return to school for the following year.

Do the work that is assigned and hand it in on time.

Extensions of assignments are made on an individual basis with the concurrence of the teacher. Without an approved extension, all work must be completed by the end of the school block. Late work will be docked 10% for each day that it is late.

To receive a letter grade for a class at the end of the semester, all work must be turned in. Each teacher will give an "Inc" (incomplete grade), provided an extension has been granted, until all work has been completed. All incomplete work must be completed within 15 calendar days following the end of the semester in question. Any student with an approved extension who does not complete his/her work with 15 school days will receive either an "F" and/or be required to repeat the semester depending upon the average grade prior to the incomplete. Teachers may grant extensions to the 15 day requirement only in extreme circumstances.

Community Service

Twelve hours of community service is required and will be accomplished at a date to be determined annually as a school-wide, inclusive process.
