

#### **FY 2018 Revenue Sources**


#### Local revenue

#### FY 2018 Expenditures



Johnson was the 1996 Ski Racing U.S. Junior Alpine Skier of the Year. He was a member of the U.S. Ski Team from 1997-99 and 2004-07.

He spent three seasons competing on the World Cup circuit (2004-07) and regularly finished in the top 10 at the National Championships, including a third-place finish in the downhill in 2006.
